

# Terms and conditions/ Disclaimer for using Recycle for Greater Manchester Litter pickers and refuse bags

## Who we are

Recycle for Greater Manchester (R4GM) is the public facing brand of the Greater Manchester Combined Authority Waste and Resources

## Memorandum of understanding

Borrowing the litter pickers and using the bags supplied by R4GM is on the understanding that your event is **not** the responsibility of R4GM and that you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

## Using R4GM litter pickers and refuse bags

- You, as the main organiser of the litter picking event must be aged 18 or over
- You agree to use Recycle for Greater Manchester litter pickers and refuse bags only for lawful purposes.
- You agree to use the litter pickers and refuse bags for litter picking events **ONLY** and not for the collection of household waste or any other uses.
- You must use the equipment in a way that does not infringe the rights of, or restrict or inhibit the use of the product by others, through deliberate damage.
- You are responsible for the collection and arranging the return of the litter pickers back to Recycle for Greater Manchester at an agreed venue, date and time.
- You are responsible and liable for the replacement costs of any broken or damaged litter pickers.

### Managing the general waste and recycling collected during the litter pick event

- You are responsible for organising the disposal of all the general waste and recycling collected on the litter pick. A list of contacts where you may be able to find support from your Local Council are given in the table below.
