You have an odd sock with a hole in the toe. What could you do with it?



You have been to the supermarket with your family. How will you take your shopping home?

You have just finished a can of fizzy pop. What will you do with the empty can?



You buy a drink from a café and are offered a plastic straw. What will you say?

You need to pack a drink for a day out. What sort of drink would you choose and why?



A button has fallen off your shirt. Is it time to throw it away?

You have a huge collection of pens at home. Whilst out shopping, you see a new pen that you'd really love to buy. What would you do?
